Sector Committee Reports: Youth: Brennan Mathias reported that youth are still focusing on the tobacco grant. Students are working to complete store audits throughout county. During the month of March, is Kick Butts Day. YAB and youth led prevention groups are working to develop efforts for schools and community. Mental Health night will be held at TCC on Thursday, February 15. TCC Y2Y has passed out T-shirts to the entire school to support mental health message and they will offer panel discussion and information booths to parents /adults that attend event. Dover has created a video PSA called "Shatter the Myths". Dover Y2Y is now in 4th year, the group is a lot stronger and the older groups are mentoring the middle school students now.

Law Enforcement Sector: Orvis plans to talk to store owners regarding the risk of where they display items and how they sell it.

The Prom Dress sale is at Dover Alliance Church set-up by Compass on Monday, February 10, at 2:00 pm. Booths can be set-up there, as well, as at the PAC on Monday, February 26, for a Risky Behavior panel discussion for the community. Miles asked that if time allows, bring the candidates running for office to hear their views on the drug issues. We need to be informed.

A Mental Health Health night is also being planned for Feb. 26th at the Performing Arts Center (PAC), this event is being planned by Tuscarawas County School Counselors (TACA), more info to follow.

Miles also reported that the **Dental Program at CMH** has hired a dentist fulltime and a dental hygenist. They will accepting only Medicaid, private pay and self pay clients for now.
